2 Person Summer 2026 Stick Curling League

This unique league will operate each Wednesday between August 5 and September 23rd. The eight weeks will be divided into 2 components or segments as described in the chart below.

August 5 – 26 (\$25.00 fee per person per 2 hour session)

45 minute practice, followed by a regular 2 person - 6 end stick game. Maximum 2 hr. ice time (Participants may opt out of either the practice or the game. Full fees apply.) September 2 – 23, 4 MINI - Spiels

Registration Fee for each Mini Spiel is \$30.00 per person per event. Fees include ice costs, prize money and nutritious snacks. All games in the Mini Spiels earn points for the Championship. The proposed schedule for the MINI Spiels is as follows:

Sept 2 nd One on One	12 players	Each person – plays 5 games. Games are 4 ends – 4 rocks per end	10:30 – 2 pm.
Sept. 9 th . A new skills based competition. (Details under development.)	24 players (12 teams)	Final format yet to be determined. Enter as a team. Teams will play against another team. The first 4 ends will essentially be used for reading the ice. The last 2 ends will involve a series of 5 skill-based shots. Points for all shots that remain in play. Points determine wins / losses/ties.	10 am until 2 pm.
Sept 16 th 2 person Mini Spiel	24 players (12 teams)	Enter as a team. 2 – 6 end games are played before a lunch break and a final game is played after lunch.	10 am to 2 pm
Sept 23 rd Championship day 2 person Mini Spiel	24 players (12 teams)	Teams will play in one of 3 groups based on points earned during the previous 7 weeks. Teams play the other teams within their assigned group. Prize money awarded equally between each group.	10 am – 2:30 pm

Individual players will be awarded points for each game they play during the first 7 weeks for ranking purpose to determine groups in the final Mini Spiel Championship Day on Sept 23rd.
